- lay aside all encumbrance.
- lay aside your needs and problems
 lay aside your self worth and
 importance
- lay aside all things that can offend deflate your inflated ego

You can't serve until you lay some things aside. You can't serve until you lay self aside. You can't serve until you lay aside the feeling of self importance and self worth. You must lay yourself aside as Christ did. He laid himself aside, forgot who he was and began to wash the feet of his disciples. This is a job reserved for the slaves. This is the time to minister to others. Rise up from the dinner table and begin to minister to other people. Start using your gifts, talents, resources, time... To serve others

Greatness is reserved for the servants Can you Serve?

Now therefore so shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the Lord of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, from following the sheep, to be ruler over

my people, over Israel:
And I was with thee whithersoever thou wentest, and have cut off all thine enemies out of thy sight, and have made thee a great name, like unto the name of the great men that are in the earth.

- 2 Samuel 7:8-9 [KJV]

This is not the only place where God referred to David as his servant. Psalm 89:20 While all his brothers sat around the supper table, David abandoned himself to service in the wilderness. And that is where the anointing located him. That is where kingship located him. The same blessing will be yours as you set yourself to serve.

While we sit down at the supper table analyzing and criticizing the food, there is a world out there cursed by spiritual hunger. They need the bread of life. While we sit down talking and discussing our favorite preachers, there is a world out there languishing in darkness. While we sit down engrossed in religious competition, Satan is having a field day attacking, engaging and molesting our youth.

This is the reason why you must Rise up from supper because supper is ended. This party is over! There are believers who specialize in analyzing the food being served.
